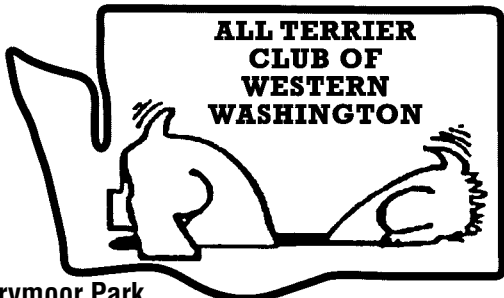

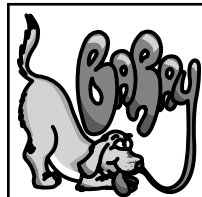
**USE OF RAMPS**

**SPECIALTY CLUB PARKING AND GROOMING**

PARKING & GROOMING WILL BE SUPERVISED BY SAMMAMISH KENNEL CLUB AND ITS DESIGNEES. All of those Specialty Clubs that have reserved space(s) in the first row only of RV parking, will be allowed to reserve the space directly in front of their parking space(s) for grooming, or other usage. The width of the reserved area will not exceed the width of the parking space(s) and will only extend 10 feet directly in front of the parking space(s). Any usage of this area that exceeds 10 feet in front of the parking space(s) will block the fire lane and will not be allowed. Fire lanes will be strictly enforced at all times by Sammamish Kennel Club.

**EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE**

If animals left in vehicles are in distress due to heat or any other circumstance, the vehicle will be forcibly entered, the animal recovered and the owner cited. If it is necessary to rescue a dog from a parked vehicle on the show grounds or in the parking area, the club will not be responsible or liable for any damage to the vehicle involved.

**CANOPIES FOR SHADE ARE ALLOWED**

Per AKC rules, they must be positioned 10 feet back from any ring. A clear walkway will be maintained around the rings. Fire Lanes will be closely patrolled, and must be kept clear.

**IMPORTANT NOTICE**

Should the on-site veterinarian determine that any dog enclosed in a vehicle is in danger, the Sammamish Kennel Club reserves the right to break into that vehicle. Anyone parking in the show site parking areas must accept full responsibility for damages should this occur.

**PARKING**

Exhibitors' parking will be allowed only in S.K.C. designated areas as required by King Co. Marymoor Park.

**PARKING RULES**

On site parking is a privilege extended by the Sammamish Kennel Club and the Sammamish Kennel Club reserves the right to withhold this privilege from any person who does not observe the rules and/or instructions of Parking Personnel on duty. Abusive language and other tactics will not be allowed and anyone unable to abide by the rules will be escorted off the premises without recourse or refund of fees. Anyone blocking the fire lanes, illegally parking in handicapped parking, driving/parking inside the show limits or tying up the load/unload zone will pay a fine of \$100.00 and will be towed away at the owner's expense and risk.

- The Load/Unload Zone has a 15-MINUTE LIMIT. PLEASE OBSERVE!
- Handicapped parkers must have and display a current/valid state handicapped permit or vehicular license plate. We have limited handicapped parking and the loading zone CANNOT be used as an alternative.
- There are NO HOOK-UPS for overnights. There will be NO discharge of ANY liquid on the grounds. Violation will cause immediate ejection from the grounds with no recourse or compensation.

**SR 520 to I-90**

**DETOUR:** For drivers headed westbound on SR 520 heading south of Bellevue.

To assist you in your travel, these are the recommended detours from SR 520/Marymoor Park, as provided by the WSDOT website.



**Recommended Detour:** Drivers will take westbound SR-520, to southbound I-5, to eastbound I-90 to southbound I-405. Drivers headed to points south could also remain on I-5. Use this route or the regional detour if possible.

**DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE:  
MARYMOOR PARK  
FROM HWY. 520 EASTBOUND**

Go east on 520 for approx. 5 miles to the W. Lake Sammamish Parkway exit. Take the right of the 2 lanes on the exit ramp and turn right at traffic light onto W. Lk. Sammamish Pkwy. Immediately move to the left turn lane and turn left at the traffic light into Marymoor Park. Follow the main road and look for Show/Parking signs.

## TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

**NOTE: BECAUSE OF TRAVEL TIME TO THE SHOW SITE, TRANSFER OF ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 5:00PM ON WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 20. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE SUPERINTENDENT ON SITE.**

**CONFORMATION:** Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

**JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP:** Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may

transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show. Correction may be made from one age division to another, provided this transfer must be made to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship class at the show.

**OBEDIENCE OR RALLY:** A dog who has earned a title after entries have closed may be moved up to the next class, provided the transfer request is presented to the Superintendent at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Move-ups may be approved provided the next level class and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.
